


J-1 scholars can travel outside the United States after they arrive at the UW, but before they leave, they must apply for a travel endorsement via Terra Dotta. Essentially, the travel endorsement is a signature from our Alternative Responsible Officers (AROs) on your DS-2019 that will allow you to re-enter the US after your travels.

- 1. Log in to <u>Terra Dotta</u> using the email address associated with your Terra Dotta profile and the password you created for Terra Dotta.
 - a. If you encounter any issues logging in to Terra Dotta, please reach out to IFSS at ifss@wisc.edu
- 2. Once you are logged in to Terra Dotta, click on the "Requests" tab within your profile. Then, click on the "Travel Signature" request.



- 3. We require the following information to process the Travel Signature Request:
 - a. Departure date
 - b. Return date
 - c. Destinations
 - d. Confirming if any of your J-2 dependents will be traveling with you
- 4. Fill out these questions to complete the form.
- 5. You may be asked additional questions before we approve the travel endorsement.
- 6. Once you have filled out the required questions, please click "Create Request" in the bottom right hand corner of the screen.



- 7. After you have submitted your Travel Signature Request, you can see if it has been processed under the Pending Requests section of the Requests Tab in Terra Dotta.
 - a. A question mark means that IFSS has not completed the request.
 - b. A check mark means that IFSS has completed the request and is working on getting you the DS-2019 for the request.
